### HUMO BLANCO SAUVIGNON BLANC.

7 / 9.5 / 27

#### LOLOL VALLEY. CHILE (13.5%)

Produced by Francois Lurton of the famed Bordeaux family. The wine has intense aromas of asparagus and tropical fruit. Smooth, tasty and well structured with balanced acidity and freshness. Perfect with a salad, goats cheese, fish or shellfish.

### SKINNY LOVE VIOGNIER.

7 / 9.5 / 27

#### CLARE VALLEY. AUSTRALIA (9.6%)

The perfect summer wine from just north of Adelaide. Like biting into a red apple, with hints of ripe apricot and citrus. Lower in alcohol which makes a refreshing change. Works with a pork stirfry and dishes using ginger.

### FOUNDRY GRENACHE BLANC.

7.5 / 10 / 29

#### CAPE OF GOOD HOPE. SOUTH AFRICA (13.5%)

Recently voted South African "wine of the year". Produced by the winemaker at Meerlust. Floral aromas with lemon, cream and white stone fruit. A rich palate of pure fruit, with a long finish. Drink as an aperitif, with canapés, chicken or cured meats.

## ROSÉ

### BOTTER CA LUNGHETTA PINOT GRIGIO ROSÉ.

#### VENETO. ITALY (12%)

A pale coral colour with a delicate nose of roses and sweet strawberries. Light and dry with good acidity. Crisp and elegant on the palate. An ideal summer aperitif, or perfect to take on a picnic.

### DOMAINE PIQUE ROQUE ROSÉ.

6.5 / 8.5 / 25

#### CÔTES DE PROVENCE. FRANCE (12.5%)

A beautifully bright and delicate pale pink in colour, with fresh scented aromas. Ripe peaches and apricots combine with a creamy middle to give a clean finish. A sublime summer rosé for the outdoors.

## REDS

### VENTISQUERO RESERVA CARMENERE.

6 / 8 / 23

#### COLCHAGUA VALLEY. CHILE (13%)

Cherry red with maroon hues. A nose of black and red fruits with spice, chocolate, tobacco and vanilla. Well balanced with big smooth tannins. A very versatile wine. Try with red meat, spicy dishes or pasta with well seasoned sauces.

### ALBRET GARNACHA. NAVARRA. SPAIN (14.5%)

6 / 8 / 23

From the Navarra region just north of Rioja. The wine has ripe cherry and wild strawberry aromas. Well integrated vanilla from ageing in French oak. Pronounced and expressive on the palate with long soft tannins. Good with grilled meats, game, cold meats, cheese and vegetables.

### FUEDO DI SANTA TRESA FRAPPATO.

6 / 8 / 23

#### SICILY. ITALY (12.5%)

Frapatto, Sicily's grape on the rise and organic too. A lighter bodied, fruit forward style of wine that could be served slightly chilled. Lively on the palate with a finish of strawberry shortcake. Pair with Italian classics; works particularly well with tomato based pasta dishes.

## CAVA

### ANNA DE CODORNIU BLANC DE BLANCS.

#### PENEDÈS. SPAIN (11.5%)

A top, top Cava that is vibrant and fresh with fine bubbles that unfold into citrus and tropical fruit flavours. Subtle brioche notes from a little oak ageing. The perfect aperitif, or with fruit based desserts, lighter starters or grilled vegetables.

## PROSECCO

### GRAN DUCA GOLD RELEASE.

#### VENETO. ITALY (11%)

The Prosecco bubble is still yet to burst! Less calories than red wine and packed full of polyphenols which are apparently good for us! Lots of youthful fruitiness with the classic apple and pear combination. Good with appetisers and snacks, shellfish and vegetarian.
